

## Filing an application with the General Settlement Fund

### Monetary compensation

All deadlines for applications have expired!

Applications for compensation to the independent Claims Committee for property losses were to have been submitted by **28 May 2003!**

### In rem restitution

All deadlines for applications have expired!

Applications for restitution of publicly-owned (on the cut off day 17 January 2001) properties or movable assets of Jewish Community Organizations are decided on by the independent Arbitration Panel for *In Rem* Restitution. "Public property" in the meaning of the General Settlement Fund Law (GSF Law) is present if the requested property (the requested movable assets of a Jewish Community Organization) were owned by the Federation or a legal person solely owned by the Federation on the cut off day, 17 January 2001. Furthermore, within the scope of Sec. 38 GSF Law, Austrian provinces and municipalities could give the Arbitration Panel jurisdiction to examine applications for restitution of provincial or municipal property (opt-in).
